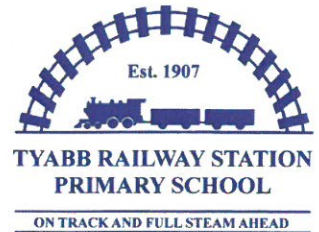


Grades 2-4 Scienceworks Excursion

As part of our Science program, students in Grades 2-4 will be going to Scienceworks on **Tuesday 25th June**. The students will **leave school at 8.40am SHARP** (please arrive by 8.30am to allow us to mark the roll and organise lunches) and will travel by bus to Scienceworks, returning at 3.15pm approx.

While at Scienceworks, we will participate in two guided activities – the ‘Earth, Moon and Sun’ educational program and the show ‘Tilt’ in the planetarium. We will also have some time for general viewing under the supervision of school staff. These activities will consolidate our studies about the relationship between the Earth, Moon and Sun in Science this term.

Students will need to arrive at school in their full school uniform and are asked to bring their snack and lunch (don’t forget a drink) in a small named bag. Re-usable plastic bags are preferred as they are light to carry and are easily replaceable if lost, but if you choose to pack Tupperware etc. please ensure each part is clearly named and that your child is prepared to be responsible for it.

The cost of the excursion will be **\$20 per student**. Money and permission form is due by **Tuesday 18th June (late payments cannot be accepted)**.
